

Nature Writing Competition 2013

RULES

- 1. The competition is open to both amateur and professional writers over the age of 16.
- 2. Articles must be no more than 2,000 words.
- 3. Articles must be sent by both post and email. The email address is editorial@resurgence.org.
- 4. Entries should be clearly labelled with: entrant's name, address, and where relevant theme (2013 themes are: Roots, Spaces and A Whisper).
- 5. We are not accepting poetry submissions for this competition.
- 6. All entries must be accompanied by an entry form and your entry fee. Only one article may be submitted per entrant. Fee £7.50 per entrant (cheques to be made payable to The Resurgence Trust).
- 7. Entries must be submitted by post to: Resurgence Nature Writing Competition 2013, Ford House, Hartland, Bideford, Devon EX39 6EE.
- 8. Articles must have be an original piece written by the entrant.
- 9. No articles will be returned.
- 10. The closing date for entries is 6 January 2013.
- 11. Resurgence & Ecologist magazine will publish all four prize-winning articles either in the magazine or on the Resurgence or Ecologist websites, free of charge. Articles will be credited to the author. Authors will receive a copy of the magazine their work appears in.
- 12. Winners will be announced on our website on 1st May 2013.
- 13. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence can be entered into regarding the competition entries.

The following prizes will be awarded:

1st Prize

Our first prize winner will be offered a place on a 5-day residential Arvon Foundation writing course (worth £655) to help hone their writing skills. They will also receive £500.

2nd Second prize

£250 plus six issues of Resurgence & Ecologist magazine (worth £30) and an invitation to come and enjoy a coastal/botanical walk followed by a good old-fashioned Devon cream tea with Satish Kumar in the glorious Devon countryside.

3rd Third prize

£75 plus a voucher for a one day residential Yarner Trust course in rural skills/creative living (worth £100).

4th Fourth prize

A year-long membership of Devon Wildlife Trust (worth £27) plus an exclusive invitation for the winner and three guests to visit the Trust's beautiful Marsland Nature Reserve for a guided tour with Senior Nature Reserves Officer Gary Pilkington.
